Applications are invited for admission to the above mentioned courses. The Subjects are :-

- 2. a) The P.G. admission procedure for the 2 year course will be conducted online.
- b) The Information Brochure can be downloaded from the official website of Calcutta University www.caluniv.ac.in After submission of online application Downloaded application forms completed in all respects along with the proof of payment of Rs. 100/= for General & Rs.50/- for SC/ST/PWD category by e-Challan will be received in the office of the concerned Faculty. If required, additional on line application may be submitted for other allied subject(s). However, Rs.100/= is to be paid by State Bank Collect or e-Challan for submission of each additional form.
- **3. Mode of payment of application fee :** For online system application fee may be deposited in any of the following manner : (a) Through "State Bank Collect" system; i) By internet banking/debit card/credit card of any bank. (ii) Make payment online at www.onlinesbi.com (State Bank Collect) and print the e-receipt. If you face any difficulty during payment please call SBI Executives at the Nos. 9674712745. For State Bank collect system additional commission for bank transaction to be borne by the candidate. Copy of the fee deposition slip (e-receipt) is to be attached with the printed copy of the application. (iii) Before deposition Cash at SBI Br., Challan to be downloaded from "State Bank Collect".

Application should be made online *from 20.07.15 to 30.07.2015.* after online submission of the application, the copy of the application is to be downloaded and printed copy of the downloaded application alongwith relevant supporting documents self-attested by the candidate are to be submitted to the concerned Secretary's Office(*From 11.00 A.M. To 3.00 P.M. on all working days*)till 31.7.2015. Application forms should be submitted either to the office of Secretary UCAC in College Street Campus or Alipore Campus whichever is applicable. B.T. Road Campus for MA/M.Sc in Economics (Details shown in the brochure vide Section no. 1 & 6.) The documentary evidence in original of the payment of application fee must be attached to the hard copy of the application.
- 5. **Reservation**: The admission of SC/ST/OBC-A/B and Person with disability candidates will follow the reservation policies of West Bengal State Higher Education Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Act, 2013 and West Bengal State Higher Education Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Rules, 2014..

N.B.

- i) Selection will be made as per university admission rules.
- ii) The list of eligible candidates for admission shall be made on the basis of marks and marks obtained by the students of affiliated colleges and the autonomous colleges under this University will be treated at par with each other. (for 60% seats) & only on the basis of marks obtained by the students at their admission test (for 40% of seats)
- iii) For Museology / Economics / Pali / Linguistics/Buddhist Studies/CILL/South and South-East Asian Studies/Archaeology/CILL, separate application forms should be submitted.
- v) Admission will be made strictly on the basis of merit, taking preference into consideration.
- vi) Selection lists will be displayed on the notice board. No personal communication will be made with the selected candidates.
- vii) Eligibility for admission of other than Calcutta University candidates: Honours Graduates. From other states recognized Universities equivalency is essential.
- viii) Percentage of cut off marks for entrance test and any other criteria will be notified after receiving the application form.
- ix) Selection will be made strictly in order of merit on the basis of percentage of marks for 60% of seats for C.U. current year students and rest 40% of seats on the basis of subject wise Entrance Test for Non C.U. and C.U. Students alongwith all back year students. **Under the category of 40% of seats**, the students be admitted on the basis of a MCQ test on OMR sheet with 50 questions on the subject each carrying 2 marks. Answers in the OMR SHEET WILL HAVE TO BE MARKED ONLY in black colour ball point pen. **Distribution of Marks**: For each correct answer 2 marks, for wrong answer minus 0.5 marks; and not attempted 0 (zero) marks will be awarded. If there is a tie of marks obtained in the written entrance test amongst the candidates than the candidates with less negative marking will be placed in higher position in the merit list than the other candidate.
