Applications are invited for admission to the Ph.D. programme in the Department of Comparative Indian Language and Literature, University of Calcutta. Eligible candidates having Master's Degree in Comparative Indian Language and Literature or any other allied literature discipline with specialisation in Comparative Indian Literature/ Comparative Literature with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7 – point scale or any other qualification considered equivalent thereto (a relaxation of 5% marks, from 55% to 50% or an equivalent relaxation of grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC/Differently-abled candidates) should apply in the prescribed form attached here with along with an application fee of **Rs. 100/-** by cash to be submitted at the cash counter through a challan obtainable from the cash counter of the University. The filled in form along with all testimonials (self-attested) and the money receipt of the application fee are to be submitted from 11:00 am to 4:30 pm on all working days to the Office of the department of CILL, 1st Floor, Asutosh Building, University of Calcutta, 87/1 College Street, Kolkata- 700073 on or before **19th February, 2019**.

Those candidates who have already passed M.Phil / UGC NET/ SET/ SLET need not appear for the RET and can directly apply to appear for the interview, provided they fulfil the minimum eligibility criteria as mentioned above. The entire admission process and all other matter related to the PhD Programme in the Department of CILL will be governed by the University of Calcutta, (Regulation for the degree of Doctor of Philosophy, Ph.D), Regulations 2016.

The candidates who have already called for interview in response to the previous admission notification need not to apply again. They will be interviewed along with the candidates eligible to appear before the selection committee against this admission notification.
