Applications are invited for admission to M.Com, M.Sc (Eco) & Museology, M.A courses in :-

Bengali, Comparative Indian Language & Literature, English, Linguistics, Pali, Sanskrit, Hindi, Urdu, Arabic & Persian, French, Buddhist Studies, History, Ancient Indian History & Culture, Islamic History & Culture, Archaeology, Museology, Philosophy, Pol. Science, Sociology, Economics, South & South East Asian Studies, Education, Journalism & Mass Communication & Commerce.

2. Forms:

- a) Submission of application form for admission to Post Graduate Courses and the payment of requisite fees will only be through online mode.
- b) Applicants from universities outside West Bengal and Applicants intending to get admission under Sports Quota are required to submit the Hard Copy of their online application forms with e-receipt attached, at the respective office of the Secretary between 28.06.2016 and 13.07.2016 from 11 am till 3 pm on all working days.
- c) For Museology, candidates with M.A. and M.Sc. degree or persons in service (see Brochure Sec.2 A, B & C) will also submit hard copy of their on-line form at the Secretary Office (Alipore Campus).
- Candidates who have passed Pre M.A. examination will apply offline on printed form obtainable from the office of the Secretary U.C.A.C.
- For Buddhist Studies, candidates with M.A. in any subject of humanities group will also apply offline on printed form obtainable from the office of the Secretary U.C.A.C.
- ♦ For Comparative Indian language and Literature, back years candidates may also apply this year.
- 3. Application Fee:
- a) An Application Fee of Rs. 100/= for General & Rs.50/= for SC/ST/PWD categories will have to be paid online at <u>www.onlinesbi.com</u> of State Bank of India.
- b) Applicants submitting additional forms in Allied Subjects, will have to pay through online mode Rs.100/= for each additional form.
- c) Mode of payment of application fee: Application fee may be deposited in any of the following manner: (a) Through "State Bank Collect" system; i) By internet banking/debit card/credit card of any bank. - **N. B.** i) Forms sent by post will not be accepted.
 - ii) Selection will be made as per university admission rules.
- iii) The list of eligible candidates for admission shall be made on the basis of marks and marks obtained by the students of affiliated colleges and the autonomous colleges under this University will be considered at par with each other.
- iv) For Museology/Economics/Pali/Linguistics/Buddhist Studies/Comparative Indian Language & Literature/South and South-East Asian Studies/Archaeology, separate application forms should be submitted.
- v) Admission will be made strictly on the basis of merit, taking preference into consideration.
- vi) Selection lists will be displayed on the notice board. No personal communication will be made with the selected candidates.
- vii) Eligibility for admission of other than Calcutta University candidates; Honours Graduates from other recognized Universities.
- viii) CU Final year P.N.C. candidates cannot apply.
- x) Selection will be made strictly in order of merit on the basis of percentage of marks for 60% of seats for C.U. current year students and rest 40% of seats on the basis of subject wise Entrance Test for Non C.U. and C.U. Students along with back year students. **Under the category of 40% of seats** students will be admitted on basis of a MCQ test on OMR sheet with 50 questions on the subject each carrying 2 marks. Marking will be made in black colour ball point dot pen. **Accreditation of Marks**: For each correct answer 2 marks, for wrong answer minus 0.5 marks; and not attempted 0 (zero) mark will be awarded. If there is a tie of marks obtained in the written entrance test amongst the candidates then the candidates with less negative marking will be placed in higher position in the merit list.
