

## Advertisement for Admission to Ph. D. Program in Hindi, University of Calcutta

Applications are invited for admission to Ph.D. program in Hindi, conducted by the Department of Hindi, Calcutta University. Selection to the Ph D. program is done by an admission test held by the Department of Hindi; it comprises of a written test and an interview. Successful candidates of the written test shall be called upon to appear for the interview. Candidates who have qualified JRF/NET/SET or equivalent or passed M.Phil. are exempted from appearing for the written examination but will have to appear for the interview.

Scale of reservation will be 22% for Scheduled Caste, 6% for Scheduled Tribe, 10% for O.B.C (A) and 7% for O.B.C (B). Attested copies of all supporting documents must be submitted at the time of application and the original must be produced at the time of interview.

Interested candidates may submit an application by filling up the prescribed form, available at the University Sales Counter, College Street Campus, 87/1 College Street, Kolkata 700073.
