A workshop titled, “Working in the Globalised World: Opportunities and Challenges” was organised by the IQAC, Internal Quality Assurance Cell of the University of Calcutta, at 3.00 pm, on 18th of February 2025, at the Senate Hall, of University of Calcutta, at the campus of 87/1 College Street, Kolkata -700073.

The workshop was inaugurated by the Honourable Vice Chancellor, Prof Santa Dutta De, the Registrar, Prof. Debasis Das, Director of Internal Quality Assurance Cell, Prof Pijushkanti Panigrahi, Former Dean, Faculty Council for PG Studies in Education, Journalism & Library Science and Professor at the Department of Library and Information Science.



The Resource persons were Ms. Urmila Chakrabarty former Professor of the University of Milan, Italy in the Faculty of Linguistic Mediation and Cultural Studies, and Director of English Hour at Milan, Italy. She was the key speaker, followed by Mr. Saibal Chatterjee, Visiting Faculty of Indian Institute of Social Welfare and Business Management, Kolkata and Director of M/S Loknath Chatterjee (MNC) Pvt. Ltd., Dr. Kaushik Bal, Development and Planning Officer, University of Calcutta and Mr Krishnendu Banerjee, The Placement Officer , the University of Calcutta.

The programme started with the felicitation of the dignitaries at the Dias with the holy enchantments, presented by Dr. Pubalika Bhattacharya Maitra, Assistant Professor, Department of Library and Information Science, University of Calcutta followed by a theme song presented by Samrat Adhikari, Student of MBA, University of Calcutta.

The welcome address was delivered by the Director of Internal Quality Assurance Cell, Prof. Pijushkanti Panigrahi. He spoke about the need of soft skill development of the students and the role of IQAC in improving the softskill development to make the students ready for global perspective.

The Hon'ble Vice chancellor Professor Santa Dutta (De) delivered a beautiful speech mentioning the IQAC role in motivating teachers, student, staff and research scholars in providing their sincere effort towards overall development of the university. She discussed at the workshop, role of IQAC in the quality control in education. The Honourable Vice Chancellor, Prof. Santa Dutta De. spoke vividly about the teacher student relationship, in and outside campus, role of a teacher in shaping students at the university levels. She emphasized on individual's working for the education fraternity. Madam Dr. Dutta De was very clear regarding the responsibility in performing the teacher ship of the professors at the University of Calcutta. She completed her speech in the vernacular language Bengali as usual. Prof. Debasis Das, the Honourable Registrar spoke very pertinently about the valuation of work and profession.

Ms. Urmila Chakrabarty was actually dealing with the global issues in cultural intersection, cross border, habits, attitudes and balances in cultural practices at official environments in India and abroad. The differences, she worked as a key compliance to have the global field as work base.

Mr. Saibal Chatterjee, nicely narrated and depicted the issues of corporate features in working status. He explained the ways how to apply somewhere; it is comparing and controlling behavioral features in professions, barriers of communication and countries with its specific public addressing.

Dr. Kaushik Bal spoke on several points of inter- country and continental features in work front. Dr. Bal spoke on students at the profession, their development and in applying their knowledge in the profession. He explained with his own life experiences for the students at this stage. Mr. Krishnendu Banerjee was the last speaker; he spoke on the platforms, national, global, investments of resources and manpower. He also surfaced the problems where students need to emphasize the potentials.

Students present at the workshop requested the authorities to have more such programmes, they want the sessions more.
