MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

University of Ruhuna, Sri Lanka and University of Calcutta, India

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) hereby signed and entered into as of this 1st day of August, 2018 by and between University of Ruhuna, Sri Lanka (hereinafter referred to as UoR) and University of Calcutta, India (hereinafter referred to as UoC). This Memorandum of Understanding sets forth the understanding of the Parties relating to the following matters:

1. To enter into a long-term collaboration, agreement and partnership based on mutual understanding and respect.
2. The collaboration aims at developing the strengths and human resources of the two institutions.
3. The elements of the collaboration shall be on joint research and consultancy, workshops, teachers and student exchange and training, and study tours.
4. Both institutions shall arrange for suitable and reasonably priced accommodation(s) for the visits of teachers and students from the partner institutions. Office facilities, computers and secretarial and other services shall be made available for the visiting professors.
5. Specific agreements for the various projects under this collaboration shall be established, consisting of purpose, expected output, activities, obligations and budget.
6. Each institution shall appoint a Co-ordinator / Project Manager for each such agreement.
7. Amendments to this MoU can be made when both the Parties agree and shall be approved in writing.
8. This agreement shall enter into force upon signature of both the Parties and shall remain in force for a period of five (5) years.
9. Upon date of expiry, the agreement shall be extended automatically for another period of five (5) years, or revoked by either Party with a written notice at least six (6) months prior to the date of expiry. Early termination will not exempt the Parties from the responsibilities of carrying out the ongoing activities.
10. IN WITNESS WHEREOF, by their signatures below, the Parties have caused this MoU to be executed in two (2) original copies in English on the date indicated below, with each original copy being equally valid. Each of the Parties shall each retain one (1) original copy.
