It is notified for information of all concerned that in terms of the provisions of Section 54 of the Calcutta University Act, 1979, (as amended), and in the exercise of his powers under 9(6) of the said Act, the Vice-Chancellor has, by an order dated 18.03.2026, approved the following amendment pertaining to the eligibility criteria regarding lapse of years from the previous qualifying examination, as mentioned in the Admission Regulations for the B.A./ B.Sc./ B.Com./ B.Mus. (Four-year Honours & Honours with Research /Three-year MDC/ Four-year Honours with a Core Vocational subject, as applicable) Courses of Studies under CCF, 2022, under this University.

Amendments

No student shall be allowed for admission after a lapse of more than 4 (four) years from the year of passing the previous qualifying examination.

(Explanation: The year of admission shall not be taken into account while calculating four years from the year of passing the previous qualifying Examination).

The above shall take effect from the academic session 2026-2027 and onwards.
