Notification No. CSR/27/2026

It is notified for information of all concerned that in terms of the provisions of section 54 of the Calcutta University Act, 1979 (as amended), and in exercise of his powers under 9 (6) of the said Act, the Vice-Chancellor has, by an order dated 08.04.2026 approved the following amendments pertaining to the Merit Index calculation to determine eligibility for taking admission in B.A./ B.Sc., as mentioned in the Admission Regulations under CCF, 2022, i.e., in the CSR/04/2023, CSR/05/2023 respectively .

After incorporating necessary amendments the new revised regulations for Merit Index calculation shall be as follows:

❖ **Merit Index calculation for Four-year B.A./B.Sc. Honours & Honours with Research Courses of Studies: Clause no. 5 of CSR/05/2023, dt. 23.6.2023 shall be read as:**

1. When the candidate has studied the Subject/ Related subject in the previous qualifying Examination, i.e., 10+2:

For the purpose of **Merit Index calculation** to determine the eligibility for admission to the B.A./B.Sc./ (Single-Major) Courses, *aggregate marks shall be calculated by **adding the marks obtained in top-four subjects and the marks obtained in the Subject/ Related subject**, which is opted as the Major subject* in order of marks secured by a student.

2. When the candidate has not studied the Subject/ Related subject in the previous qualifying Examination, i.e., 10+2:

For the purpose of **Merit Index calculation** to determine the eligibility for admission to the B.A./B.Sc. (Single-Major) Courses, *aggregate marks shall be calculated by **adding the marks obtained in top-four subjects only**.*

However, marks in compulsory Environmental Education/Studies shall not be taken into account for calculation of aggregate marks. However, if the subject "Environmental Science" is studied as an elective subject of 100 marks, it may be taken into account for the purpose of determining the aggregate marks.

Explanation of Related subject: As mentioned in the CSR/05/2023, dt. 23.6.2023 against specific subject (s).

Rest part of the clause 5 and other clauses of the said CSR remain unchanged

❖ **Merit Index calculation for Three-year B.A./B.Sc. Multidisciplinary Courses of Studies:**
Clause no. 5 of CSR/04/2023, dt. 23.6.2023 shall be read as:

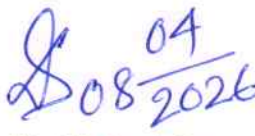
For the purpose of **Merit Index calculation** to determine the eligibility for admission to the B.A./B.Sc. (Multidisciplinary) Courses, aggregate marks shall be calculated by **adding the marks obtained in top-four subjects only** in order of marks secured by a student.

However, marks in compulsory Environmental Education/Studies shall not be taken into account for calculation of aggregate marks. However, if the subject "Environmental Science" is studied as an elective subject of 100 marks, it may be taken into account for the purpose of determining the aggregate marks. Seat reservation for admission in the first year class of three-year (six semesters) degree courses

Rest part of the clause 5 and other clauses of the said CSR remain unchanged

The above shall take effect from the academic session 2026-2027.
