Notification No. CSR/83/2026

It is notified for information of all concerned that in terms of the provisions of Section 54 of the Calcutta University Act, 1979, (as amended), and, in the exercise of his powers under 9(6) of the said Act, the Vice-Chancellor has, by an order dated 14.07.2026, approved some amendments in the Examination Regulations of B.Music. of (4-year Honours & Honours with Research), as published under CSR/11/2024, dt. 07.03.2024 as mentioned hereunder:

For B.Mus. (4-year Honours & Honours with Research) Courses-

Clause No. (12) of CSR/11/2024 shall be read as

A candidate clearing all the papers of the 1st to 6th semesters and also completing a 3 credit Internship, and exiting the course at the end of the 3rd year shall get.

Three-year B.Mus. Degree with Single Major in (Hindustani Classical Music/Rabindra Sangeet /Bengali Songs), as the case may be.

Clause No. (13)-i & ii of CSR/11/2024 shall be read as

Candidates of the said Courses who appear in all the semester-end examinations from semester-1 to 6 are eligible to continue in the Semester-7 classes as Honours candidates in the same college where the candidate has been pursuing the course, irrespective of their result status in the previous examinations.

However, for taking exit from the pursuing course after semester-6, they have to secure minimum 30% marks in all the papers of first six semesters including Summer Internship.

To continue in the Honours with Research Courses, they have to secure minimum 30% marks in all the papers of first six semesters including summer Internship and at least CGPA 7.5, calculated after successful completion of semester-1 to 6 examinations as mentioned in the respective Examination Regulations.

If a candidate secures a minimum of CGPA 4.00 but fails to secure a minimum 7.5 may re-appear all the 5th or 6th Semester End Examinations or both, at the immediate next available chances within the stipulated period of time to obtain a minimum CGPA of 7.5.

Clause No. (22)-iv of CSR/11/2024 shall be read as

A candidate clearing all the papers of the 1st to 6th semesters and also completing a 3 credit Internship, and exiting the course at the end of the 3rd year shall get.

Three-year B.Mus. Degree with Single Major in (Hindustani Classical Music/Rabindra Sangeet /Bengali Songs), as the case may be.

The above shall take effect for B.Music (4-year Honours & Honours with Research) Courses of studies under CCF,2022 which was introduced from the academic session 2023-2024 and onwards.
