# Resolutions of Amendment of Clause 9.2.3 and 12.2, 12.3, 12.4 respectively for 4 Year B.FAD Honours CCF 2022 Regulations (CSR /10/2023 DATED 10 JULY 2023)

### 1.0 Amendment of Clause 9.2.3;

9.2.3 Any candidate failing to earn 50% of the total credit allotted for a particular semester (for e.g. 12 credit out of 24 credit) will be allowed to continue classes in the next higher semester and he or she may be allowed to appear in the supplementary examination to be held in the next year in the same semester to pass those papers in which he or she has failed to obtain his or her credit of that semester.

A candidate may not be allowed for supplementary examination in the papers he/she has failed if he or she had not obtained 50% of the total credit of that semester and may be allowed to continue in the next semester and has to appear in all the papers as a fresh candidate of that semester with the next batch.

## 1.1 Amendment of clause 12.2, 12.3, 12.4:

- 12.2 A candidate who is eligible to appear at an Semester End Examinations but does not enroll or does not appear at the examinations or fails to secure pass marks in one or more paper(s) at the concerned examinations, will also be allowed to appear in that failed semester examination along with next higher batches as applicable and the candidate is eligible to attend the next higher semester classes and also to appear in semester end examination within the limit of 6 semesters in order to become eligible for continuing their studies in 7th and 8th semester.
- 12.3 A candidate may appear at a higher semester end examination without appearing in a lower semester end examination.
- 12.4 A candidate who fails to secure pass marks in one or more papers of a semester may appear in those paper(s) when the concerned semester end examination will be held in next batches.

#### Explanation:

Candidates not eligible / not enrolling for a lower semester end examination will be eligible to join next successive higher semester classes and appear at the respective examinations if otherwise eligible. However, such candidates shall have to join and enroll in the lower semester and will have to appear at the corresponding semester end examination before joining semester classes of 7th and 8th semester.
