**Admission Criteria for B.Ed.Course, 2014-15**

**As resolved by the Syndicate dt.24.02.2014 confirmed by the Syndicate dt.04.03.14 and approved by Pro-Vice-chancellor for Academic Affairs on 05.03.2014 it is to notify that all B.Ed.Colleges including self-financing colleges under C.U. (a) should conform to admission procedure adopted by the University with regard to its B.Ed. Course of Study; (b) Accept the fees structure proposed by West Bengal Higher Education Council; (c) Admission list be published only after endorsement by the University.**

**Admission Criteria for B.Ed. Course, 2014-15**

Admission to the Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.) course will follow the norms set by the NCTE, the State Government and University of Calcutta.

1. The course is opened for candidates with graduate degree (Pass/General/Honours / Major) or Post graduate degree (with 50% marks in aggregate in case of candidates belonging to General Category, 45 % marks for Differently Abled Category, Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe Categories).
2. Reservation of seats for B.Ed. admission (only for fresher category)
  - i) Calcutta University.....95%
  - ii) Other University .....5%
3. Reservation of seats for Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe and Differently Abled will be as follows
  - i) Scheduled Caste .....22%
  - ii) Scheduled Tribe .....6%
  - iii) Differently Abled .....3%
4. Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribe applicants from the other states will not get the reservation facilities for SC/ST.
5. Deputed Candidates shall be selected only on the basis of period of approved service mentioned in Clause 8.
6. Age limit:  
For fresher students (General Category) ..... 40 Years (as on 30<sup>th</sup> June)  
For deputed students (General Category) ..... 45 Years (as on 30<sup>th</sup> June)  
  
Age limit is relax able for maximum 5 (five) years for students belonging to Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe and Differently Abled Categories.
7. Fresher (Non-Deputed school teacher) candidates will be selected on the basis of Academic Merit only. Weightage given for Academic Performance and the calculation of grade marks are as follows:

- v. Madhyamik Pariksha or its Equivalent ----- 10

**\*Academic Marks will be awarded only at single stage of Under Graduate and Research Degree Level.**

8. Selection of Deputed Teacher of Secondary School / Madrasah affiliated to W.B.B.S.E. / W.B.B.M.E. will be made on the basis of the period of approved services in the School / Madrasah. In case applicants having equal service in Secondary School / Madrasah, preference will be given to the candidates having higher Academic Qualifications. In case of both the Period of Service and Academic Qualifications are equal, selection will be made on the basis of percentage of marks obtained by the candidates in different examinations in their career and candidates having higher grade marks will be selected (**Grade Marks calculation will be done as meant for Fresher Candidates**).
9. Reservation of 50% seats for Deputed Teachers and 50% for the freshers for admission to B.Ed. courses will be followed.
10. The method subjects should be in the form of subject quota depending on the number of subjects being offered by the respective college.
11. Method subjects to be chosen from the subjects studied at under graduate level by respective candidates having 300 marks for freshers only.
12. As per N.C.T.E norms each method subject should have a maximum of 35 students for admission.

Students should be selected strictly on the basis of merit. Merit list to be approved by the respective Governing Body of the college and also by Inspector of Colleges / Vice-Chancellor before admission.
