Interested candidates are requested to appear for a walk-in interview on 19th June, 2019 at 11.00 A.M. in the room of the Head of the Department of Zoology, Calcutta University, 35, Ballygunge Circular Road, Kolkata-700019 to work as a Junior Research Assistant (JRA) in the project entitled “Delineating the role of the Hippo signaling pathway components in maintenance of pluripotency, chemoresistance and metastatic properties of breast cancer stem cells: clinical and therapeutic implications.” funded by DBT, GoWB, under the guidance of Prof. Urmi Chatterji of Department of Zoology. Tenure of the position is for three years.

Qualification required: M.Sc. Degree with a minimum of 55% marks in any branch of Life Science with valid NET /GATE qualification. Desirable: Experience in animal handling and inclination to work in the area of cancer and molecular cellular biology.

The upper age limit for JRA shall be 30 years, which is relaxed up to 5 years in the case of candidates belonging to Schedule Castes/Schedule Tribes, Women, Physically Handicapped and OBC applicants. Fellowship and admissible allowances per month will be as per the sanction of the funding agency and also as per norms of this University.
