



**Notice for Extension of Deadlines pertaining to the Ph.D Programme of University of Calcutta**  
**Under COVID-19 Pandemic Situation**

[This Notice is for the Ph.D. enrolled and registered students (vide relevant Ph.D regulations of C.U.) who have failed to get themselves registered and re-registered for once only respectively / or to submit thesis within the tenure of registration between 15.03.2020 and 30.09-2020.]

Ph.D students falling under the above categories will get an extension for the period of 6 (six) months w.e.f. 01.10.2020 under the following conditions as applicable for respective categories:-

1. Enrolled probationary Ph.D. students must fulfil all the criteria as laid down in the relevant Ph.D. regulations.
2. Ph.D. students who are willing to get themselves re-registered (1<sup>st</sup> time) with benefit of continuity must be re-registered under existing Supervisors(whole time faculty members) as per relevant Ph.D. regulations of C.U. Otherwise, if any supervisor of a Ph.D. student retired from the service the student may be able for get re-registration after inclusion of a Joint or Associate supervisor from the whole time faculty members of the concerned Department recommended by the relevant Ph.D. Research Advisory Committee for obtaining the required permission for said re-registration.
3. Those Ph.D. students who are willing to get extension for the purpose of submission of thesis must get completed all the procedural formalities as per relevant provisions of the Ph.D. regulations for submitting the same on or before last date of extension.
4. For any other purpose extension is subject to fulfilment of necessary pre-requisites pertaining to the said purpose.

**N.B.** 1. There are provisions for online application of Ph.D. **registration, re-registration** and **submission of thesis**, details of which are envisaged in the respective Notice in [www.caluniv.ac.in](http://www.caluniv.ac.in) under COVID-19 Pandemic Situation.

2. All the provisions mentioned above are subject to change depending on situation which will be intimated through subsequent notification.
