Eligibility Qualification: M. Sc. in Electronic Science/M. Sc. in Physics with Electronics specialization or equivalent. **Candidates must be CSIR/UGC-NET/GATE qualified or equivalent.**

Desirable Qualification: Preference will be given to the candidates having knowledge in the area of semiconductor devices/processing and Bio-sensors.

Period of appointment: The post is purely on temporary basis for a duration of 1 (one) year and further extendable subject to satisfactory performance and on successful evaluation of progress, to a maximum of 3 (three) years or the completion of the project whichever is earlier. It would, therefore, not confer any right for any candidate for claiming extension.

Fellowship: As per DST norms, Rs. 31,000/- per month plus admissible HRA.

No TA/DA will be provided for appearing in the interview.
